**FUNDRAISING & TAGGING**

The majority of funds the Corps raises each year comes from the 4 tagging days held each spring and fall. Tagging is the only fundraising event the 676 undertakes each year so its success is critical.

All the money raised stays with the 676 and is used to fund the cadet activities. Most times cadet activities are offered for free or heavily subsidized. The list below is only a partial account of activities cadets will have the opportunity to enjoy and the cost of providing each.

Although tagging has always been a mandatory event, in 2008 and 2009 all cadets will be required to work a minimum of three tagging shifts of approximately 3 hours in length during both the spring and fall tagging cycles. Cadets that do not complete tagging requirements will not be eligible to participate in subsidized events without an additional payment that closer reflects the actual cost of providing that activity. In addition, eligibility for summer camp and to participate in optional events may be affected.

## **WHAT DO I NEED TO PURCHASE FOR MY CADET?**

The 676 works hard to absolutely minimize the cost associated with being an Army Cadet. Many events are free and complete dress uniforms and PT Gear (Physical Training) are provided at no cost to all Cadets. We do have several items however we highly recommended that cadets purchase.

For use during field training exercises and camping trips we recommend Cadets purchase combat clothing. Canadian style solid green combat pants, a tunic, a green tee shirt and combat boots are available at army surplus stores. Most surplus stores will offer a cadet discount, be sure to inquire. Listed below are 3 local surplus stores.

We also recommended that all cadets acquire a high quality sleeping bag with a below zero temperature rating. For some exercises, sleeping bags are provided but for many they are not. As an example, for Rattlesnake Point, Fort George/Niagara Falls and Pinery, sleeping bags will not be provided and cadets must supply their own.

Optional items for the cadets would include a small flashlight and a folding camp chair. A kit list appears in the description of each event on the web site.



## **TRYOUT FOR THE 2008-2009 RIFLE TEAM**

Tryouts for the 2008-2009 Marksmanship team will be held in the early fall. Watch the website for updates on dates and times.

The team will consist of 7 members, 2 of which will be alternates. The team will compete at competitions during the year. Practices are expected to be held once a week and will be posted on the website.





## **SCUBA INSTRUCTION**

In the spring of 2009, the 676 will offer Scuba Instruction and certification as part of our optional training program. It is our intention to offer this program every year in addition to dive opportunities in the spring and fall to those already certified. The program will be open to silver and gold star cadets. The planning for this program is still in its early stages so details and dates may change.
